



Ready! Rally! Play! (RRP) Class Information

Youth Improvement Family of Classes • Ages 7-15

Our Ready! Rally! Play! family of classes is a fun, welcoming program for beginner through intermediate players who are starting tennis or continuing to build their fundamentals. The objective of the program is to establish a solid foundation of technique, movement and control from which players can build their game and enjoy tennis for a lifetime!

How enrollment and placement works:

Ready (beginners) is for students with little to no tennis experience. This program is typically taken for two sessions. After Ready, players automatically move into Rally/Play.

Rally/Play: Players enroll in the combined Rally/Play class and are grouped on court by level: Rally (advanced beginner) or Play (intermediate). Coaches may adjust groups throughout the session to ensure the best fit for drills and games. Players graduate from Play into Bronze Team or Competition training after meeting class goals.

Ready (Beginners)	Basic technique, ball striking, tracking, racquet control, and footwork; intro forehand, backhand, volley, and serve	Age 7-12 - Orange Age 10-15 - Orange/Green	Rally/Play
Rally/Play (Advanced Beginner - Intermediate)	Continued fundamental technical development. Emphasis on rally, serve, and ball control with more movement. As students improve we focus on building consistency; advancing swing technique as we move toward points and matches.	Age 7-12 - Orange Age 10-15 -Green	Bronze Team or Competition Training with coach approval

Class goals and moving up to Bronze Team: Players are ready to graduate from RRP and move to Bronze Team when they can consistently demonstrate the following skills:

- Serve consistently into the designated box and sustain a rally from the baseline off both sides on a 60' (orange ball) court or larger (orange or green ball based on age and skill)
- Competent technique on basic strokes (forehand/backhand)
- Play points with correct scoring, etiquette, and sportsmanship
